
Using our Table Cover Templates.

Choose the program (software) you'll use to put together your file. We offer templates for 3 major programs (Adobe Photoshop, Adobe illustrator and Corel Draw)


In Adobe Illustrator

1. Download the Illustrator template by right clicking on the template's name and clicking on "Save link as" and saving the template to the desktop or folder of your choice.



2. Open the PDF file with illustrator




3. Open the Layers Menu and Select the Artwork Here Layer




4. Add your artwork

6. Save your file as a PDF and Send over to Us




In Photoshop

1. Download the Illustrator template by right clicking on the template's name and clicking on "Save link as" and saving the template to the desktop or folder of your choice.




For Corel Draw Files

1. Download the Illustrator template by right clicking on the template's name and clicking on "Save link as" and saving the template to the desktop or folder of your choice.


